This is a pretty straightforward assignment:

- Come up with two ideas for narrative tableaux in which all of your classmates (and your professor) have an ACTIVE role. Although not required, some of the more successful ideas in the past have played with the history of photography, or with current events (news, popular culture, etc).
- Your ideas must be “do-able”:
 - The props and costuming should be items that your classmates already have (ideally) or would be very easy (and inexpensive) for them to find.
 - The location should be a place that you know and have (legal) access to.
- Also, unless you’re volunteering to do the work yourself, there should be minimal post-production required.

Finally, via the Facebook link I’ve posted on the class website, view the examples from some of my previous classes -- your job is to come up with better ideas than what your predecessors came up with.


After you’ve developed your ideas, fill out the following two pages including the storyboard squares. Be clear about your ideas (the following sheets need to stand on their own without explanation).


